



TREATMENT RECEIVED AN NON-WVR APPROVED FACILITIES

In order to ensure that WVR participants get the best possible care, WVR seeks to have individuals attend a Treatment Program of their choice that is approved by WVR. Treatment Programs approved by WVR meet minimum guidelines of accreditation and often specialize in healthcare professionals.

However, WVR recognizes that at times individuals seeking treatment may not wish or be able to attend a Treatment Program approved by WVR. Reasons an individual may seek treatment from a Treatment Program not currently approved by WVR may include insurance limitations, cost, personal philosophy or accessibility. When an individual goes to and completes treatment at a Treatment Program not currently approved by WVR, WVR reserves the right to have the participant evaluated by an WVR approved evaluator for stability and/or recovery status before they are allowed to return to work.

1. Individuals or participants needing treatment will be given a minimum of three approved choices by WVR.
2. If the individual or participant does not wish to attend a WVR approved Treatment Program, they may elect to attend another program that meets WVR general guidelines.
3. Upon completion of treatment, the individual or participant may be required to have an out-patient or in-patient evaluation with a WVR approved Treatment Provider or Treatment Program.
